


Enhancing the lives of military veterans and their families.

The *Hero Smiles Teams* rolled up their sleeves with four veterans' organizations:

- Volunteers prepared and served a meal to veterans and their families at Fisher House.
- Team members created 150 toiletry kits for veterans receiving medical care at the VA Hospital.
- At the **Veteran's Leadership Program (VLP)**, our volunteers painted the lobby to create a warm and welcoming space for visiting veterans.
- Volunteers at Shepherd's Heart beautified the Hill District building's exterior and also organized the group's South Side food pantry location.

Supporting family wellness and fitness.

The Sharing Smiles Teams shared their time with three non-profit groups:

- Team members spruced up the campus at **Sarah Heinz House**.
- Volunteers organized the clubhouse and beautified the golf course at First Tee of Pittsburgh.
- At Camp Guyasuta, volunteers repaired the grounds after some major flood damage that occurred in 2018 so that kids can experience all the outdoor fun and play that the camp has to offer during the summer.

Our spirit of volunteerism spans more than just one day – it extends throughout the entire year. Eat'n Park Hospitality Group hosted more than 12 additional volunteer opportunities, and our team members logged over 33,000 hours through their own personal volunteer efforts. Pretty incredible, right?





VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

Every year, we honor one individual who goes above and beyond for their community. This year, our Volunteer of the Year was **Kayla Frattini**, our Corporate Support Center Hello Bistro Marketing Manager.

Kayla spends most of her volunteer life investing in two separate organizations. The first is the Miracle League of the South Hills, which gives kids and adults with disabilities the opportunity to play baseball. Kayla coaches two Miracle League teams – an adult team and a youth team. Because she spends so much time with the athletes, she has developed incredible bonds with many of them. (One even asked her to his high school prom!)

Kayla's second passion project is with **Team PHenomenal Hope**, an organization that raises funds and awareness for a rare medical condition called Pulmonary Hypertension. Over the last few years, Kayla has gradually increased her level of involvement in the organization's annual 5K fundraiser from participant to now serving as the Race Director for the second year in a row. Kayla's favorite part about volunteering, and probably the core reason that she dedicates so many hours to service, is that she is helping to build a community of inclusivity.

On Kayla's behalf, Eat'n Park Hospitality Group donated \$1,000 to the Miracle League of the South Hills.

This includes supporting our neighbors through our annual **United Way** Campaign, which raised more than \$220,000 this year. These generous contributions continue to make an impact and a difference for many people in our communities.

Our team members also spend countless hours volunteering for our annual **Caring for Kids** Campaign, which raises funds to support free care services in pediatric hospitals and programs in the communities where Eat'n Park Hospitality Group has a presence. What makes this campaign truly unique is that it's completely driven by our passionate team members. Plus, funds generated at each site benefit the hospitals in each local community.

From basket raffles, to jeans days, to raffling off a brand new Ford Ranger (thanks Neighborhood Ford Store!), our 2019 campaign raised over \$360,000, bringing our total contribution over 41 years to more than \$11 million. These totals most certainly wouldn't be possible without the dedication and support of our team members, guests, and partners.

Our team members also love Hello Bistro's **Give Some Green Program**. For every signature salad a guest orders, ENPHG donates the funds to purchase produce for a local community food bank. Through this program, we support four food banks throughout our operating region and are proud to donate a total of 30,806 pounds of produce in 2019.
